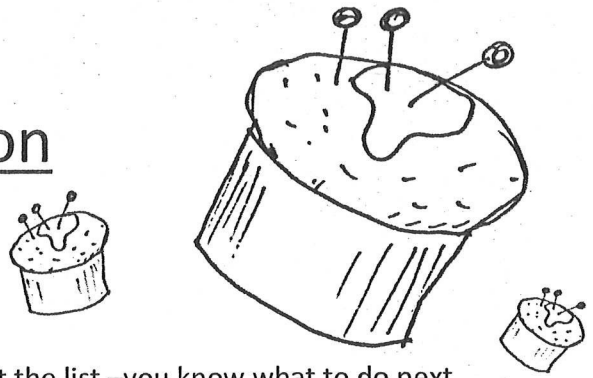


A Fantasy Muffin Pincushion

DESIGN AND MATERIALS



Draw a picture of your fantasy muffin, write how it tastes



Choose materials that fit to your design



WORKING ORDER

"THE MUFFIN BASE"



Draw 1 cm seam allowance to your pattern



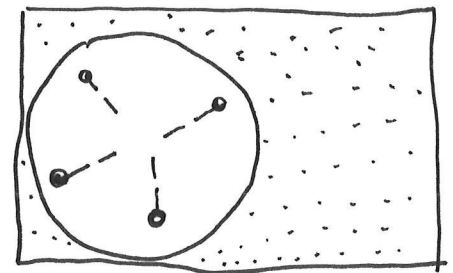
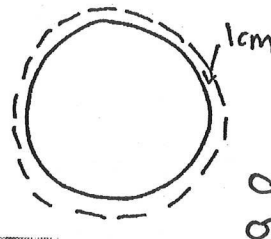
Cut the pattern



Place the pattern on to your fabric, use pins!



Cut the fabric; follow the lines of your pattern



DECORATION



Iron piece of the IRON-ON ADHESIVE to the back side
your decoration fabric (Use cover paper!)

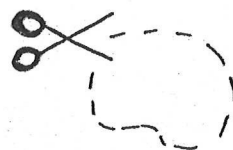
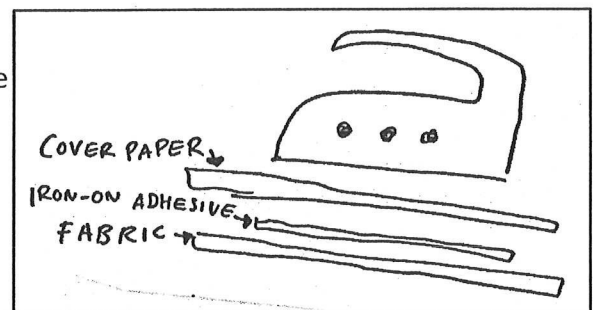


Draw a mirror image of your decoration figure
on the back side of the fabric (and Iron on adhesive)



Cut the figure carefully; follow the lines

Remove the cover-paper

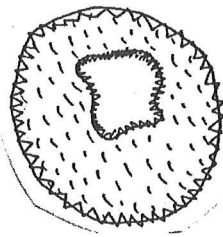
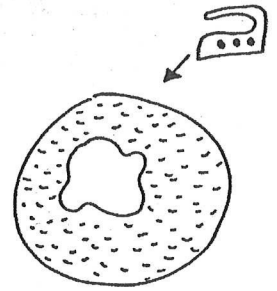




Iron your decoration figure on to the "Muffin base" (Use cover paper!)



Sew a tense zigzag or a straight stitch on the edge of the decoration figure



TENSE ZIG ZAG:

Stitch Width (SW): 3-4

Stitch Length (SL): 1-2

STRAIGHT STITCH:

SW: 0

SL: 3-4



Sew zig zag on the edges of the muffin base

ZIG ZAG:

SW: 3,5

SL: 3,5

"BAKING" THE MUFFIN



Sew the outline by hands (use pearl cotton threads)



Tighten the tread



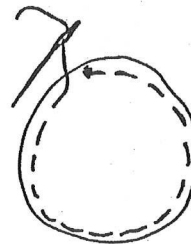
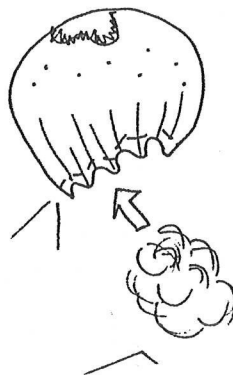
Fill the muffin



Sew the hole in



Cut extra treads off



DECORATE THE MUFFIN PAPER



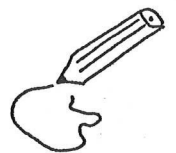
Cut a rectangle-shaped piece of fabric/ cardboard that covers the can



Decorate the band



Glue the decoration band to the can



AT LAST THE MUFFIN WILL BE GLUED IN TO THE CAN WITH HOT GLUE: TEACHER WILL DO IT FOR YOU
